Downtown restaurant deliveries restricted by time, location during detour

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO – During the Grand Avenue Bridge detour, restaurant vendors and suppliers will **not** be permitted to load or unload on 7th Street, 8th Street, or in the alleyways adjacent to these streets. Restaurant deliveries will only be allowed on the west side of the 700 block of Cooper Avenue and the east side of the 700 block of Colorado Avenue, from the hours of midnight to 11 am, daily. This area will be monitored by police for compliance. Drivers attempting to make deliveries outside of these locations or this time frame will be subject to fines and possible towing of their vehicle, should they end up blocking or even partially blocking traffic.

There are about 20 restaurants in the downtown area, all of them needing to be stocked with supplies on a near-daily basis. In the past, delivery trucks could park on the street, typically blocking a lane of traffic. Due to the traffic demands of the detour route, this will not be possible during the 95-day bridge closure, as doing so would lead to excessive backups and delays.
