## Garfield County EAB to hear Energy Master Plan

A front range consultant will present the recently completed Energy Resources Inventory for Garfield County at the Feb. 6 Energy Advisory Board (EAB) meeting.

Erin Degutis, senior project manager for TRC Solutions, will deliver an overview of the inventory part of Phase I of development of the Energy Master Plan for Garfield County.

The EAB meets from 5:30-8 p.m., at the Rifle Library, 207 East Ave. Dinner is provided for meeting attendees, and citizens are invited.

The program will focus on how the project collected publicly available digital information and developed maps of the data using geographic information systems.

"Garfield County possesses a variety of renewable and conventional energy resources," said Degutis. "They are in a landscape that is home to abundant wildlife, active recreation opportunities, agriculture, and rural living."

"The energy resource maps will allow the county to identify the location of existing resources and develop policies that can direct development of energy resources in context to existing natural resources and regulatory constraints."

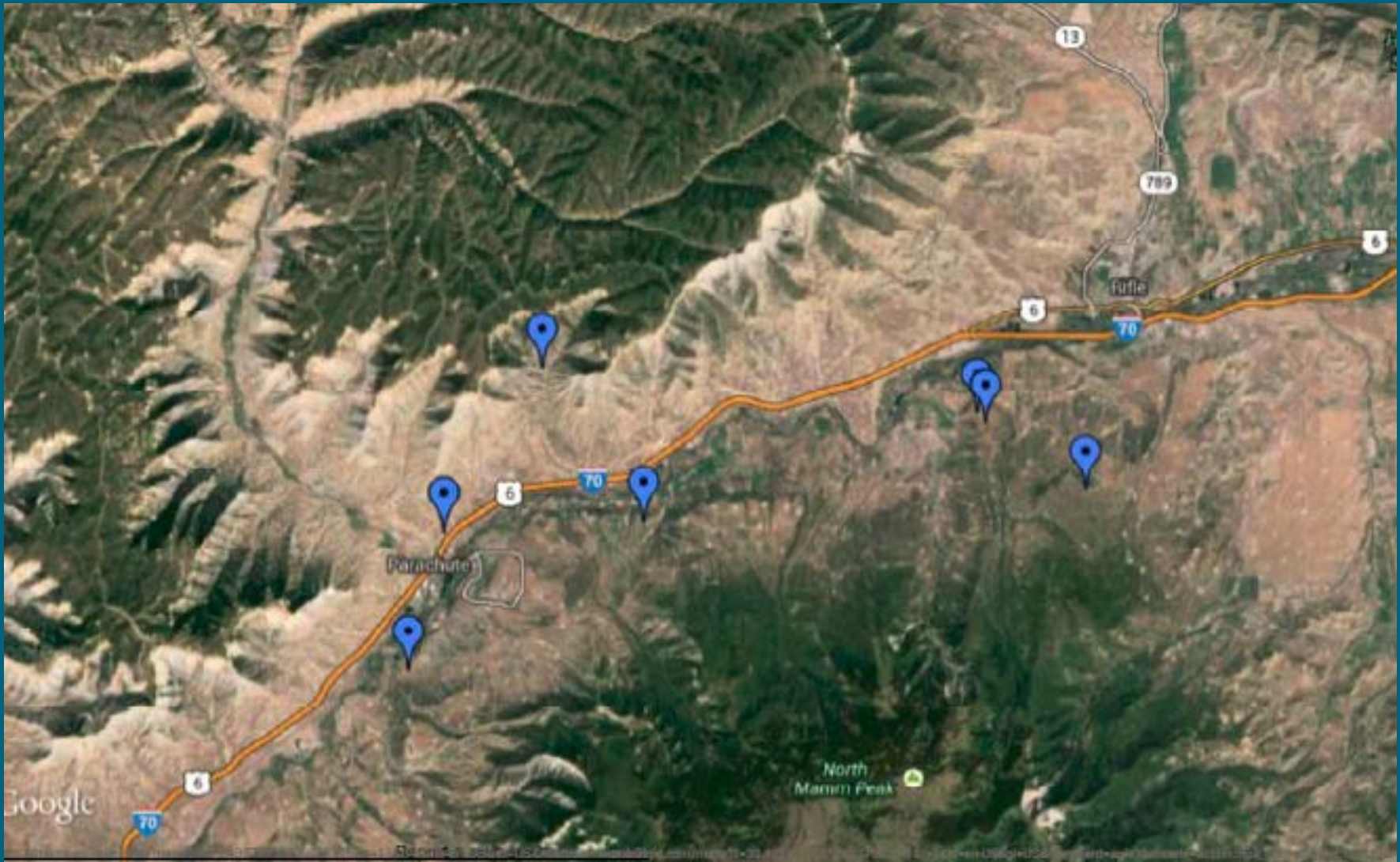
At 5:30 pm, dinner is provided for meeting attendees. The meeting and presentation begin at 6 pm.

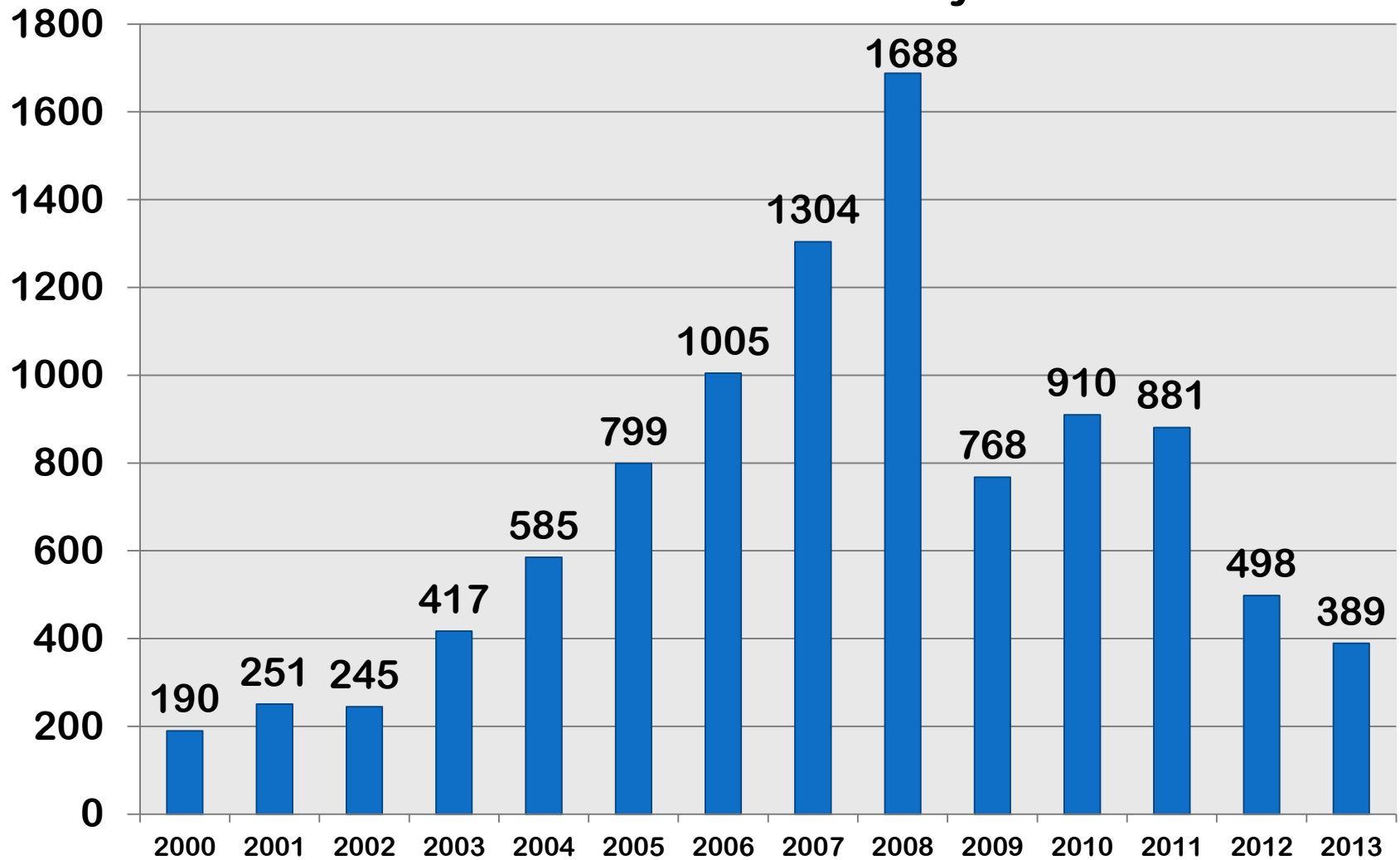

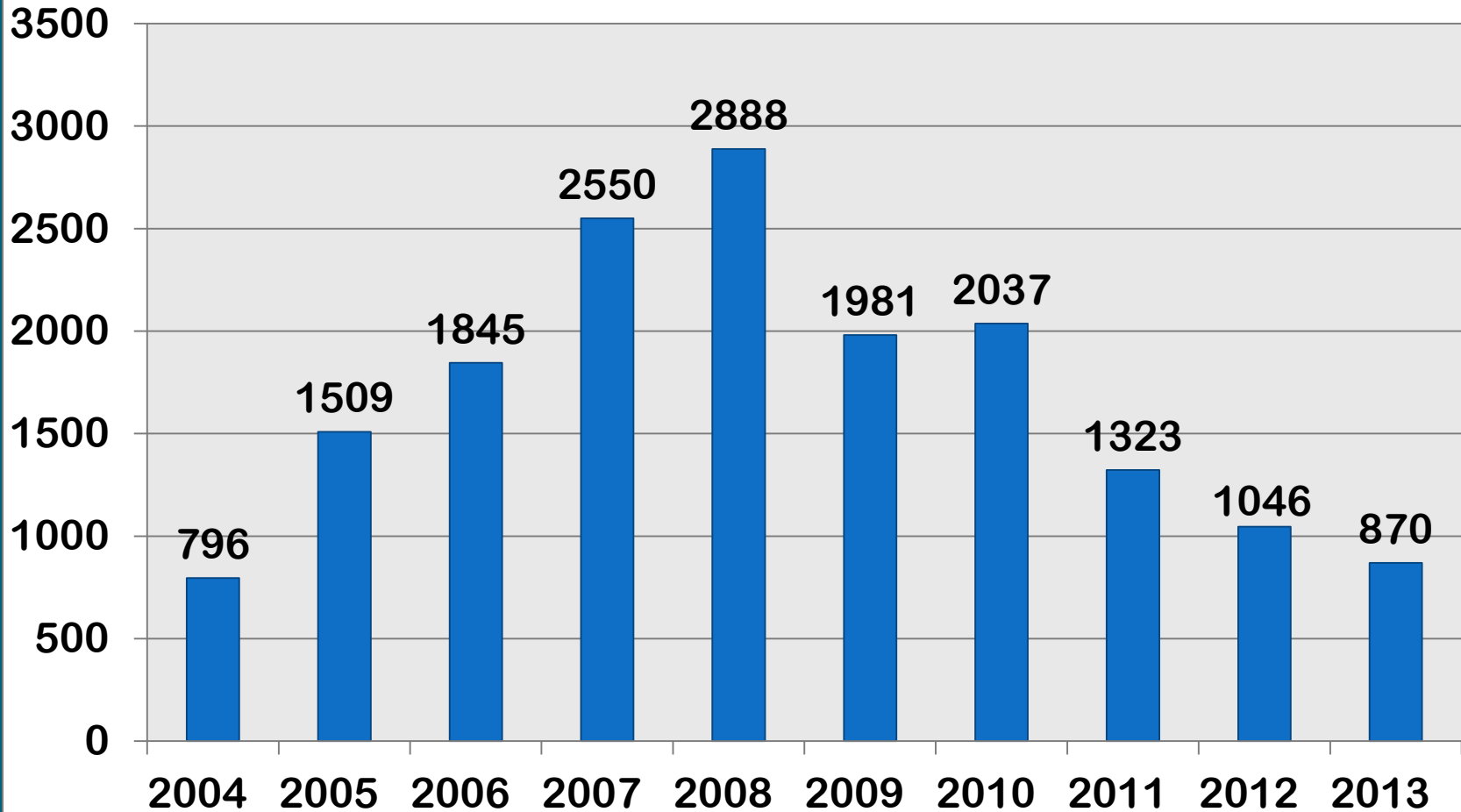
# Annual Garfield County Gas Well Totals

# Colorado Air Quality Control Commission Rulemaking

# Colorado Air Quality Control Commission Rulemaking

The AQCC is considering revisions related, but not limited, to:

- **Full adoption of 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart OOOO (NSPS OOOO: VOC performance standards for O&G storage tanks)**
- **Air pollutant emission notice reporting and construction permit thresholds**
- **Additional control measures for oil and gas operations and equipment that include control of ozone precursors**

# Colorado Air Quality Control Commission Rulemaking

- **Garfield County Submitted Prehearing statement**
- **Garfield, Moffat, Rio Blanco, Mesa and Montezuma Counties participating in rulemaking as a coalition**
- **Garfield and the other Counties submitted joint statement of support for stronger regulation of oil and gas emissions and requested flexibility in the finer details for implementation**
- **Air Quality Control Commission Hearing is Feb 19-22, with public comment allowed on Feb 19<sup>th</sup>.**

- **Feb 19-23, 2014** – Rulemaking Hearing (Denver), **Public Comment accepted in person or by phone (with preregistration) on the 19<sup>th</sup>.**
